Club repeaters and System Fusion

The Club currently runs 3 Yaesu DR1X repeaters, with a DR2X currently in testing. The 31 and 440 machine are both in auto in/auto out mode, so they will transition between C4FM and FM analog seamlessly based on what mode is received. 39 is in FM only mode, and 220 is not a System Fusion repeater.

System Fusion uses CF4M for digital voice and data. Currently, none of the repeaters are connected to the larger Wires X digital system, but that is soon to change when the DR2X goes into service. Repeater users with a System Fusion II capable radio (some radios may require a firmware update) will soon be able to connect to connect our repeater to Wires X rooms with other repeaters around the world!

More on this will be coming soon from the RAB in 2023!

Repeaters! (a sneak peek of the future!)

Earlier this year, the club had a New Yaesu DR2X Fusion repeater donated. The goal of this new Repeater is to replace the 145.31 machine to be a full fledged fusion Repeater utilizing Yaesu Wires X and be fully compatible with Yaesu Rooms. This will allow club members to remotely connect to repeaters all over the region, country, and even the world. The RAB is currently testing the functions, and setting parameters, and hopes to have this machine live shortly after the 1st of the year.
