We will also have a bylaws amendment that will be presented by the ad hoc special committee that created the amendment. The amendment will be open for discussion at the April meeting and will be voted upon in may.

The text of the amendment is:

"Article XII. Electronic Meetings

"Meetings of and within the organization may be held particularly or fully via electronic means.

"The membership may adopt standing rules for electronic regular club meeting participation which shall be contained in a single document that may be adopted or revised at any regular meeting of the club by a 2/3 vote of the members present.

"The executive board may adopt standing rules for electronic executive board meeting participation which shall be contained in a single document that may be adopted or revised at any executive board meeting by a majority vote of the executive board members present.

"The repeater administrative board may adopt standing rules for electronic RAB meeting participation which shall be contained in a single document that may be adopted or revised at any RAB meeting by a majority vote of the RAB members present.

"Committee chair shall have sole discretion to publish rules for electronic participation in meetings of their respective committees."

From the President's corner:

At the April meeting the annual election of officers will be held. The officers positions up for election are Vice President and Treasurer for 2 year terms. The President's position will be open to finish the remaining 1 year of the 2 year term. As you know I agreed to step up and hold the office of President when the previous president resigned and left the club in 2022. As I stated when I became president last year I would not be running for any elected position as my home front duties and responsibilities were increasing. I served as VP for 18 months before taking the President's position. As VP the main role is to head up a group that develops monthly programs for the club. I have also completed the VP's role by continuing to develop programs for the rest of this fiscal year.

I appreciate the confidence the club has in me to continue for the past few months as president.

If the club is to continue as an active club it is time for some younger members to step up and assume leadership roles in the future of the club.
